## The Lord Will Fight For You

Passage: Exodus 14:13-14

This weeks questions will look different given everything that is going on. There will be one question to meditate on followed by a time of guided prayer.

In this passage we see a beautiful promise that Moses gives the people of Israel on God's behalf. "The Lord will fight for you, and you have only to be silent." (vs14). Spend some time meditating on this truth. How have you experienced God fighting for you? What has this looked like in your life? How is this true in the larger, cosmic sense even if it doesn't **feel** like it's true day to day?

## A Time of Guided Prayer

- Pray for those that have lost their homes, businesses and been displaced or evacuated.
- Pray for the Fire-fighters and First Responders that are on the frontlines battling these fires and providing help.
- Pray for God's will to be done and that you would have eyes to see what He is doing during these turbulent times. Pray for a revival in our city and for the courage to speak of the hope that you have when the opportunity arises.
- Pray a prayer of praise that God is in control and that He has fought for us and continues to fight for us to this day. He is with us and we can trust Him to give us the strength to endure anything that comes our way. For we are more than conquerors and can never be separated from Him.
